Chapter 3 offers an overview of treatment options for kidney replacement therapy. It includes transplant, hemodialysis, the vascular access, peritoneal dialysis, and home dialysis. The next chapter turns to acute kidney injury (AKI) and presents useful information pertaining to AKI, its causes and treatments. Chapter 5 discusses care of the pediatric patient by the APRN.Additional information on almost all of these topics can be found in the other modules of the Core Curriculum for Nephrology Nursing.
